



Monthly Message From Rabbi Bahar

Summer is a wonderful time to enjoy some pool time, a cool mint julep, and a ride on the Ocmulgee River. Rabbi Victor Reichert, a well-known Reform Rabbi from Cincinnati, OH would advise his congregation to use the summer months as a time for reflection and renewal.

He would encourage people to read a good book, enjoy a long walk, and find a friend for coffee. He would celebrate the longer days with an invitation to do things differently by taking time for ourselves and things that we appreciate. Summer can be an opportunity for change and growth not just a time to chill out.

The summer months in Macon tend to be scorchers – a time when things need to be moving slower. Some of the changes at the Temple to stay cooler will be a return to the social hall for services.

Another thing which I would love to engage with you is a new class I would like to teach at lunchtime on Wednesdays. This will be a brown bag lunch in the Temple social hall. The class will be a six-week class entitled "The God We Don't Believe In." It will explore different understandings in Judaism of God from the Biblical period through the modern era. It is intended for those who have had little knowledge or experience. Considering only 17-18% of college-educated Jews say they believe in God according to a Pew Study, with another 58% believing in a Higher Power – this class should have some lively discussion.

Another change is a summer congregational morning walk at 8:45am. For those who are walkers – We can go for a walk together Monday mornings at Amerson River Park. This is intended for us to remember what it was that Rabbi Joshua Heschel wrote in his book God in Search of Man: "Awe enables us to perceive in the world intimations of the divine, to sense in small things the beginning of infinite significance, to sense the ultimate in the simple; to feel in the rush of the passing the stillness of the eternal..." It will be an opportunity to remind ourselves of the awesome sound of a bird chirping, a deer grazing, and the beautiful green around us.

Things that will stay the same over the summer will include Kiddush Club as we continue to work through the book on Haftarah. Services will remain on time. I will also remain available for appointments and am happy to meet you at your home or out for coffee.


